Our school's name is Lodovico Benvenuti He was an Italian partisan during World War II and a politician after liberation.








Building

In our school there are 15 subjects:


- English: we study English grammar and culture

- History: we study the history behind a war and important historical personalities









WHAT IS/ARE YOUR BEST SUBJECT/S?






WHAT IS/ARE YOUR WORST SUBJECT/S?

Books and Materials

- Books: books aren't free. In every book there is a CD or DVD for homework and multimedial exercise.
- Maps: in every class there is a Geography map.
- Class: in each class there is a closet for our books and a computer with IWB for the lessons and an old blackboard with chalk. We haven't got lockers or food machine.
- Corridors: there are recycling bins.
- In the school a lot of art materials: felt pens, coloured pencils, watercolors, tempera, brushes and papers.
- In the gym some gymnastic materials: balls, mattresses, ropes for jumping, ball for throwing weight and wortex.
- In the school there are classrooms with special materials for example in the Science Room: skeleton, elements for experiments and chemical objects.











Our school is technological (materials and devices) and digital (to learn).

In each classroom there is an interactive IWB and a computer.

We have a lot of special classroom:

- IT classroom: in this classroom there is an IWB and 17 computers;
- Atelier creativo: in this special classroom there are 2 IWB, 8 computers, a green screen and 6 large and rectangular tables (for group works);
- Science classroom: in this classroom there is an IWB and a computer;
- Auditorium: a classroom with a big IWB and a computer (for meetings).

At school we sometimes do digitalized tests and school research on the net. We use Google Apps too:

- ★ Drive: to share our teaching materials and to do our homework;
- ★ Classroom: to communicate with teachers.


Our parents can see the marks and our homework in the Electronic Register, filled and signed by teachers every day.
